



## Swimming Attainment data at Croftway Primary Academy:

**KS2 Swimming and Water safety** is taught and “blocked” throughout Y4 to all classes.

Pupils who have not met or exceeded the minimum National end of KS2 requirement by the end of Y4 are provided with FREE *TOP UP Swimming Lessons in Year 5*.

### **Use Government PE Funding:**

*Over the last few years we have used part of our PE and Sport Funding to pay for this **Y5 TOP UP Intervention Programme**.*

*This TOP UP Programme is designed to assist individuals, in small groups, in reaching the End of KS2 National Minimum standard of 25 Metres.*

Most children in TOP UP groups receive a full term of TOP UP in Y5 . This typically equates to a minimum of 10-12 sixty minute lessons, or more if required.

**Staff** and the Leading Teacher for PE monitor the quality of teaching, learning, behaviour and progression at Blyth Leisure Centre Swimming Pool..

**Service Providers** are Active Northumberland (Northumberland County Council Leisure Services) **Swimming Teachers** teach the lessons and are supported by Class Teachers and TAs. Pupils are encouraged, tracked and moved up as they progress towards *confidently and proficiently swimming at least 25 metres, using a range of strokes effectively such as front crawl, backstroke, displaying knowledge of safe practice and performing safe self-rescue in water-based situations*.

We adhere to the **Active Northumberland Leisure Services Guidance** on swimwear and **National advice** and guidance provided by the Association for PE (AfPE) on Swimming.

Thanks to weekly Y4 lessons and these Y5 TOP UP Swimming Lessons being delivered across the whole year, **we are significantly exceeding the National average** of approximately\* 69% achieving the National Minimum Expectation of 25 Metres \* Source : National Swimming Report developed by the Curriculum Swimming & Water Safety Review Group (March 2017)

**2014-15 Swimming attainment data:** 60% of our departing Y6 cohort met or exceeded the National end of KS2 minimum 25m target (no TOP UP in place)

**2015-16 Swimming attainment data:** 79% of the departing Y6 cohort met or exceeded National end of KS2 minimum 25m target

**2016-17 Swimming Attainment data:** 87% of the departing Y6 cohort met or exceeded the National end of KS2 25m target

**2017-18 Swimming Attainment data:** (At time of writing on July 2018):

- 46% of our current Y4 have met or exceeded the National end of KS2 25m target
- 96% of Y5 have met or exceeded the end of KS2 (Y6) target
- 86% of our current Y6 have met or exceeded the end of KS2 25m target and they also won the Blyth Pool Olympic Legacy Gala in 2017 & 2018

**2017-18 Y5 TOP UP SWIMMING COHORT** (30 pupils):

**Cohort total = 30 pupils** 53% of this in the cohort are categorised as **PP**

**Autumn 2017:** 100% of group 1 met the end of KS2 Minimum Target

**Spring 2018 :** 100% of group 2 met the end of KS2 Target in Overall (at time of writing),

**Summer 2018 (July)** 93% of final Y5 TOP UP group (least able) met or exceeded end of KS2 target.
