All Students

- No big hair accessories including large bows
- No earrings or jewellery at all except plain watches
- No nail varnish
- No make-up

<u>EARRINGS ARE NOT PERMITTED</u> - If your child comes to school with a piercing, you will be contacted to remove them if they are unable to do this independently. Staff cannot assist with the removal of earrings or other piercings. Piercings should take place during the 6 week summer holidays to allow enough time to heal.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION -

In hot weather, children can wear a cap and should come to school wearing sun cream.

Religious and cultural clothing can be worn; this should be discussed with the Head of School.

Jewellery (including body piercings) religious artefacts, watches and glasses should (where possible) be removed to ensure a safe working environment

Disclaimers from parents about the wearing of any item of jewellery will be declined—your child will be asked to remove any piercings. If they are unable to remove them themselves, you will be contacted to remove them.
